STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW INFORMATION DISCLOSURES (34 CFR 668.45)
JULY 1, 2018

The federal ***STUDENT RIGHT TO KNOW ACT*** requires that annually (no later than July 1) institutions of postsecondary education prepare and disseminate information about their graduation rates of full-time, first-time in undergraduate programs leading to a certificate, associate's or bachelor's degree. In addition to disclosing information related to graduation rates, the institution must also disclose information about:

- Graduation rates shall be detailed by gender, by race as defined by the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), by Pell Grant beneficiary, by beneficiary of a Direct Loan that did not receive Pell Grant, and by students who did not receive either Pell Grant or Direct Loan.
- Retention rates as reported to the IPEDS.
- Employment placement rates as well as job types obtained by graduates which are available at <http://www.ftccollege.edu/disclosures.html>.
- Types of graduate and/or professional education in which graduates of any institution's 4-year programs have enrolled.
